- Vendors must provide their own "booths" and all other necessary displays. Be prepared for all types of inclement weather, especially wind.
- Setup begins at 7:30 am and vendors are expected to be **ready for business by 10am.** Vendors are responsible for their own setup and breakdown in the space designated to them. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area orderly and free of trash.
- Booths **must** remain open until 5:00pm on Saturday and 4:00pm on Sunday. If not, vendor forfeits the chance of returning to the event next year.
- Anyone selling food, beverages, herb products or any other items intended for human consumption agrees to comply with all licensing and public health regulations and **will display necessary Licenses.**
- Vendors are responsible for collecting/reporting 7.8% sales tax for the Town of Friday Harbor.
